Dear Senator Rockefeller:

On behalf of the National Association of State Medicaid Directors (NASMD) I am writing to follow up on our previous letter of support that we sent to you in August 2009 extending our support for S. 1111, the "Special Disability Workload Liability Resolution Act of 2009". As you know this legislation would be instrumental in resolving the Social Security Administration's (SSA) computer processing glitch which resulted in a failure to identify Supplemental Security Income (SSI) recipients who had become eligible to receive Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI). We know that SSA is aware of this error and is working to correct the amount owed to the disabled individuals; however at this time SSA has yet to determine how they will rectify this liability owed to states which is why this bill is so important to us.

We are hopeful that Congress will vote to approve this bill to ensure a speedy resolution of this matter. As you know, states are facing significant budget constraints and this bill would greatly assist states with their current fiscal crises. We also understand that you are working to possibly get this language inserted into the Senate Jobs Bill and we would like to extend our support to this process as well.
